Does your child have needs relating to social, emotional, physical, Additional Support Needs developmental difficulties or delays??



Have you made the school aware of these?

Has your child been experiencing difficulty with friendships, bullying, family bereavement, changes in family circumstances, frequent house moves?



Have you made school aware?

What should you do?

Complete admission form giving full details, talk to your child's teacher.



Make appointment to meet with the school ASN co-ordinator (Mrs Bokor), arrange to come along to ASN Parent Support Group

What help can be provided?

ASN teaching input may be available, ASN Auxiliary support may be available, access to certain computer packages may be available, classroom assistants may be able to help in the classroom.



Sometimes pupils receive support on a 1 to 1 basis but usually small groups are made up.

Working with outside agencies?

The school can do referrals for a range of support services such as Occupational Therapy, Speech and Language, Educational Psychology, Behaviour Support...
