

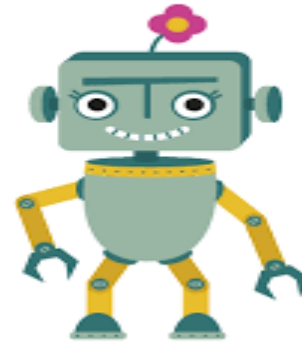


In Primary 1 we have been learning about Keeping Healthy.
