Eye Matching Game

- Print, laminate and cut sheets into individual cards.
- Separate cards into two piles, one pile containing the close up of eyes, the other showing the whole creature.
- Distribute the eye cards to the children (maximum group size—10).
- Teacher keeps hold of creature cards and shows the group one card.
- This is an opportunity for discussion and language extension.

• If a child believes that they have the corresponding eyes for the creature, they must say why. If they are correct, they then take the place of the teacher to show the next creature card to the group.

• Play continues until all cards have been matched.

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
