Activity 1

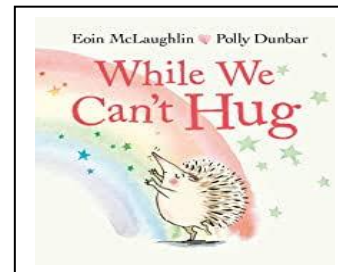

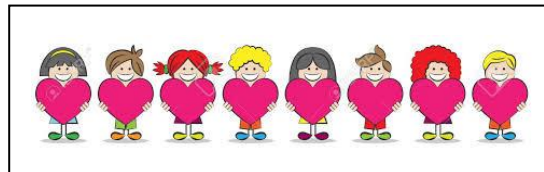
Activity 2 - Main lesson

This week I would like you to listen to this lovely story about two friends who cannot share a hug. It's called 'While We Can't Hug'.

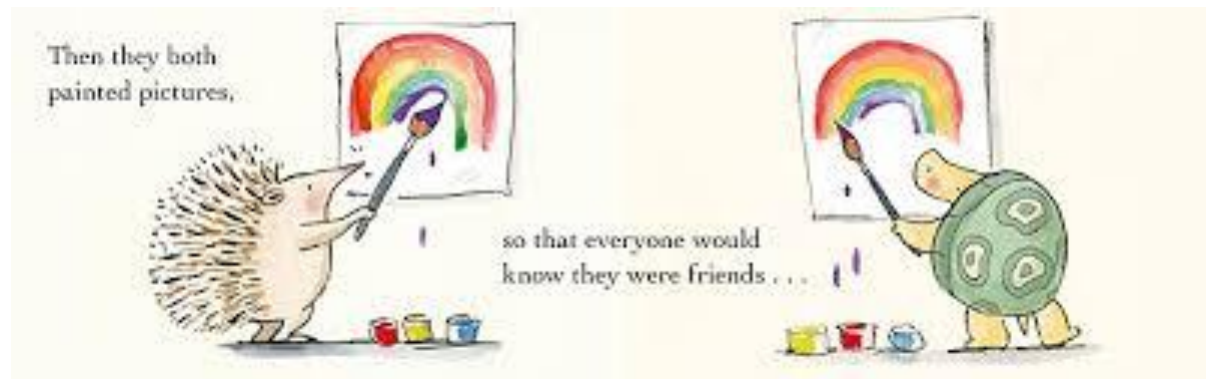
