## **Recycled Circus Game:** Ring Toss

This is a fun way to turn leftover paper plates and kitchen rolls into a fun craft activity and game for your children.

## You will need:

A kitchen roll tube

Four paper plates (although you can make more rings if you wish)

Sticky tape

A pair of scissors

Paints and stickers to decorate

## **Instructions**:



- 1. Cut four slits into one end of the kitchen roll tube (each about one centimetre) and bend back the kitchen roll to turn them into flaps.
- 2. Using the sticky tape, attach the flaps of the kitchen roll tube to one of the paper plates to make a stand. You may wish to decorate this stand as this will be used as the target for the ring toss.
- 3. Carefully remove the centre circle from the other three plates so you are left with the outer ring (this can be done by gently folding in half before cutting).
- 4. Paint and decorate the rings and leave to dry.

## **Playing the Game**

Place the target on the floor. Choose a standing point from which all the players will throw the rings. Take it in turns to throw the rings at the target. Try to get each ring over the target to earn a point. The person with the most points is the winner.
