#### **6. Digital Portfolios - presented by Rachael**

Profiling is important as the children need to be aware of the things they are good at, things they enjoy so that they can promote themselves in the world of work.

It would be great to get more people into school to talk about what things they enjoyed that led them to the world of work path they are on now. Note: they would all need to be PVG.

The school have started to use a digital profile through GLOW and Google Slides which each child will have access to, to record their own learning and achievements, and supported to annotate their evidence. The language used will be Meta Skills.

Gail has currently taught the children how to log on and attach a photo for annotation. The children will need to justify why the photo is to be taken, linking to Meta Skills and curriculum targets. The profile is saved in a shared drive on Glow and each child can only access their own one.

The profiles will cover the 4 areas of: life and work at school, interdisciplinary learning (IDL), the curricular areas, and opportunities for personal achievements.

The school are hoping that they will be able to share the profiles with families at the next parents' evening.
