On Fridays, we will develop our skills and coordination for sports.</p>	<p><b>Technologies</b> We will use design skills to make and create to meet a criteria.</p> <p>We will develop our skills in coding by programming the <i>Programmable Toys</i> and <i>Makey Makey</i> to meet a challenge.</p>	<p><b>Religious and Moral Education</b> We will learn about and reflect upon beliefs in other religions and cultures about creation stories. At second level we will explore ‘belief’ and the diversity of beliefs locally and nationally. We will discuss our learning about scientific theory about creation compared to creation beliefs.</p>
