Estimation and Rounding & Number and Number Processes

Early Level

In school, we are helping children explore size, amount, and quantity through play and real-life experiences. They are learning to count, put numbers in order, and use practical materials to add and subtract by counting forwards and backwards.

First Level

Children are learning to estimate answers, solve number problems, and check if their answers make sense. They are also developing their understanding of how numbers are made, including the role of zero and the value of each digit.

Second Level

Pupils are building on their number skills by using rounding to estimate and check answers. They are working with larger numbers and decimals and exploring place value and negative numbers to understand how these are used in real-life situations.
