To join, download the Safer Schools App which can be found on the Apple or Google App Store. The QR code below will help you select version (i.e. parent or pupil). Please ensure you use the correct joining code below:

2. Enter the four digit entry code (see picture on the right) for your unique role.
3. Alternatively, you can scan the QR entry code (below) by clicking the 'Scan QR code' button on the app login screen, which will automatically log you in.

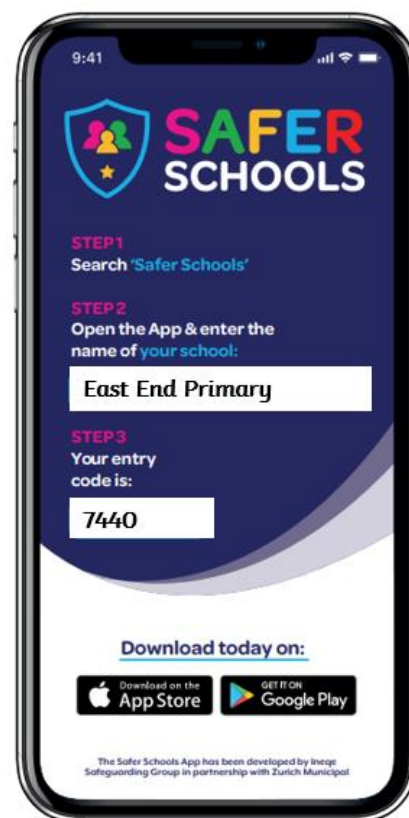
P5-7 Pupil Login

Moray Badge

The Moray Badge Platinum Jubilee is a project to help primary and secondary aged pupils who have been affected by the Covid-19 lockdown. The project aims to encourage children to participate in and enjoy outdoor activities and to develop their own strengths rather than competing against other. The aim of the project is to benefit pupils and schools by having a positive impact on mental health and well-being as well as on learning in the classroom. East End Primary has registered all pupils to take part.

The Platinum Badge is for young people in S1-6 aged 12-18

The Copper Badge is for children in P5-7 aged 9-12

The Brass Badge for children in P1-4 aged 5-9.

Each badge has three levels so pupils will start at Level 1. Please see the table below for East End:

Your child's class teacher will specify how they're going to facilitate and record activities for the class. Please look out for this information on Teams.

There are some activities that the children will be able to tick off from school through Bike Ability, Wild Things, Abernethy etc. and class teachers will be providing opportunities to children to complete other activities from the levels too.

Each pupil needs to complete at least five of the activities shown to graduate to the next level and pupils may repeat some activities if they want, rather than five separate activities. We will be offering opportunities for pupils to complete tasks in school and we hope you can enjoy completing some tasks at home too.
