Dear Parent/Carer

Last session, we successfully introduced an online system called Show My Homework (SMHW) to help pupils and parents keep track of homework and we will be continuing its use this year. I am writing with information that will give you access to SMHW so you will have the ability to see the details of the homework tasks your son/daughter has been set, deadlines and their submission status (e.g. submitted or not submitted) and grades if applicable. We decided to introduce SMHW in response to feedback from parents who said they wanted more details of what homework was being set in order to support their children more effectively. This system has improved the way we communicate with parents and the information we share regarding homework.

S1 pupils have set up their SMHW account in school and I have attached your own parent login details for your personal SMHW account where you will be able to see your child's 'To Do list' and also any homework details. To log on, please follow the instructions on the attached sheet and use the Parent Code to set up your account. You can do this on your mobile phone, computer, laptop or tablet. To keep up to date by using your mobile phone/tablet you can download the Show My Homework app and you will then be sent push notifications to let you know what homework is due and if your son/daughter has submitted their homework. If you have several children with us, you can link them together to save logging in to different accounts. To view all homework set without logging in, please visit our school website where you will find the link for Show My Homework.

Please log on and set up your account by Monday 10th September so you are able to start using SMHW to support your child with their homework.
