Sharing the love of reading!



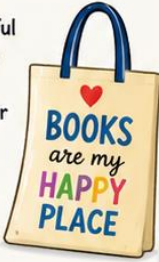
On Friday 15th May, Fiona Maxwell from Reading Force visited Hopeman Primary School to share her love of reading books with our young people from Armed Forces families.
