The children had lots of fun feeding pigs, goats, sheep, emus and alpacas using special animal food.

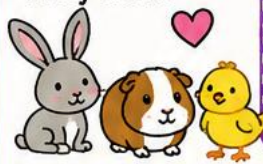


There were plenty of smiles (and giggles!) as some very lively lambs eagerly bounced over, hoping for their turn to be bottle fed!
