

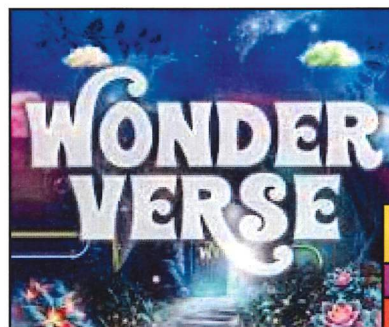

P7T enjoying their NERF wars marble treat!

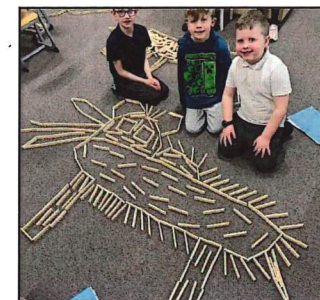
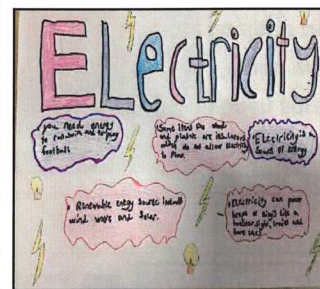


More great work with Active Schools. Our after school sessions for pupils who have neurodivergent conditions has been a huge success!

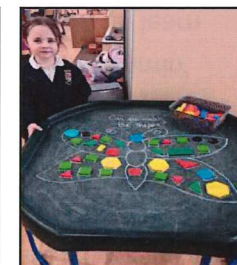
Interdisciplinary Learning
