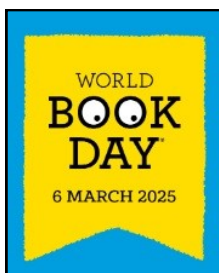

P2C have been learning to use tools in the woods. We have learnt to whittle sticks using potato peelers and made them into mark making tools. They use their sense making and focus skills.



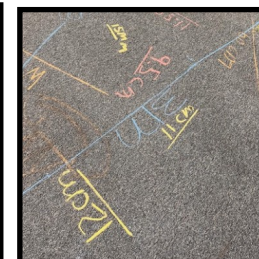
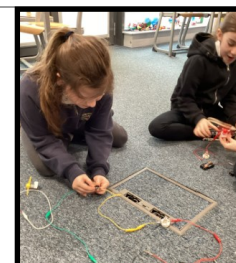
P5/6H have been getting creative this month building a 3D city using different nets!
