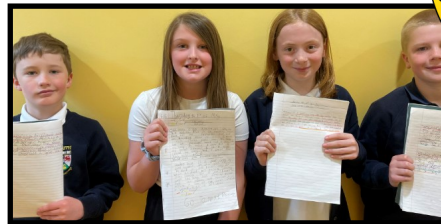


Isla-May, Bella and Kate visited Weston View to present the £120 they raised through selling lucky bags.
