Opportunities for Personal Achievement



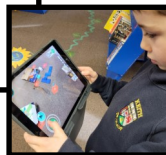
Keith Active Schools + Keith Library are currently teaming up to run a block of target sports + crafts sessions. Great to see KPS pupils joining in!

Some P4 and P5 pupils took part in a Digi Fun session at Keith library to develop their STEM skills. The pupils represented their school wonderfully.

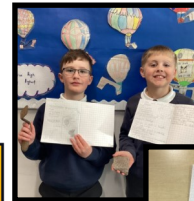

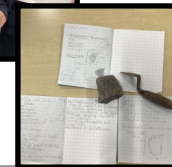
Ethos and life of the school as a community

Interdisciplinary Learning

P6-7G were challenged to work in pairs to create a buoyancy device that would keep a key afloat. These are the successful students who met the criteria: the device fits in your pocket, stays afloat for one minute and you're able to use the key without destroying the device.



P6H chose to study the Dinosaurs as their IDL topic. This week, they have worked on their research skills, looking at the size and scale of these animals. Taking on the role of palaeontologists, they started by looking at the evidence left behind in their foot-steps, and plan on mapping out the strides of 6 different species in the hall!



P1EM have been learning to form letters correctly. They had a sound disco where they dimmed the lights and played some party music! They used finger torches to form their focus sound around the classroom.



P2C have been learning to use the paint function on the laptops- from opening the document to creating a picture using the drop down tools to create and colour the picture.



P7T have been learning about Buoyancy, completing a hot and cold water experiment to see how currents are made. They investigated why the sea was salty and then made their own tinfoil boats. The winning boat design held 186g of small weights before sinking.

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All classes from P5-7 took part in bridge building workshops with AMCO. Lots of budding engineers!

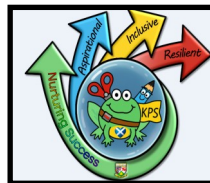

Well done to Callum who was awarded the Heather Stanning Award in October.



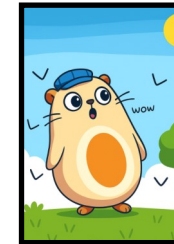
Well done to all winners of our Value awards in Term 1.



Our vision and values pupil group have been working with Miss Douglas and Mrs Grieve to finalise designs to represent our refreshed vision and values.

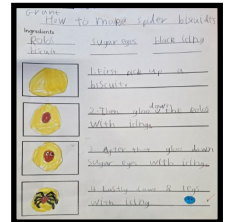
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Interdisciplinary Learning
