

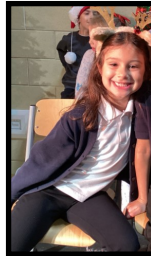
# LEARNING ACROSS THE 4 CONTEXTS AT KEITH PRIMARY SCHOOL: DECEMBER 2025

Congratulations to the newly elected members of the new Pupil Council (aka the Froggy Forum).

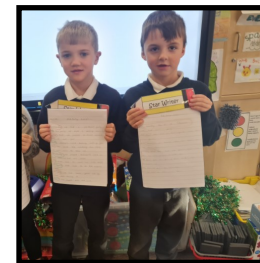
