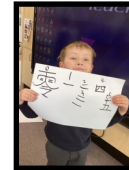

P2F made a friendship chain that included words of kindness for World Book Day after we read the story 'The Boy with Flowers in his Hair'.

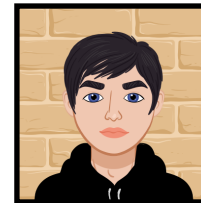

P1EM have been learning about Chinese New Year and how it is celebrated.

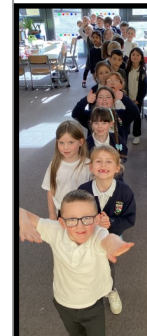


P4H designed avatars as a safer alternative to a profile picture.
