Interdisciplinary Learning

During their outdoor learning session, Primary 1 used saws to help build a dead wood fence. They explored the forces of pushes and pulls as they moved the saw backwards and forwards through the wood. They worked together, took turns, and developed their confidence using real tools in nature.



P4MH have been learning about the Vikings this term. After learning about the Viking raids they asked if they could make their own Viking shields. They were also able to identify that they were using a range of Metaskills including communicating, collaborating and creativity.

In P5 Steven & Jenna (Dorenell Rangers) were demonstrating how effective Blanket Bog Moors are for creating natural dams. This nurtures ecosystems while preventing water draining too fast and creating floods in the town. They were shocked at how effective it was!
