If you walk, cycle or scoot three times a week for a month, you get rewarded with a badge.








If you arrive by car you can park at the Moray Sports Centre carpark and use the path that leads straight to the school. This will mean you can still take part in the WOW Travel Tracker.

What will you need to take with you?

Ask your family to write your name on school uniform and any items of clothing you take to school so you don't get them muddled with your friends!



You will also need an apron to keep your school uniform clean when you are doing messy activities (remember an old shirt will do and put your name on this too).





When you go to the toilet you take the toilet cone and put it where you are working. This lets the teachers know where you are.

We always remember to flush the toilet and wash our hands. We have sniffle stations



in the classroom to keep our hands clean and help keep as healthy. You will love meeting Inky, Snake and Bee in Primary 1 because they help teach you lots of sounds.
