

glow What Glow should be used for?

Glow is Scotland's nationally available digital environment that can be used to support learning across the whole curriculum.

Eligibility for an account requires individuals to work directly with learners or in the support of curriculum delivery. PVG or Disclosure checks are required prior to the issuing of accounts.

Inappropriate Use

Direct contact with parents via learner account (requiring login).



Collaborating and sharing with non Glow users - e.g NHS and non Education satff.



Storage of sensitive data that you would not be happy if it was seen by others outside your control.



Sharing login details and storing/sharing inappropriate or copyright materials

Appropriate Use



Communicating and sharing resources with learners.



Collaborating with colleagues on creating learning resources and school organisation.



Storing learning materials so they can that can be accessed on any wifi enabled device.



Creating Glow Blogs or Google Sites to post appropriate information or resources for parents.
