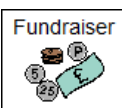
ECO

FUNDRAISER – SPORT RELIEF 2016

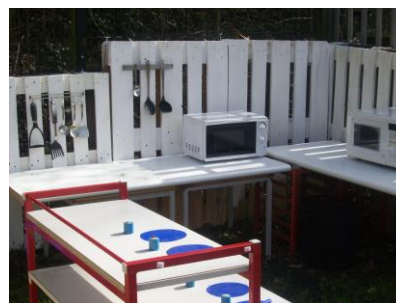

PARENTS' EVENING



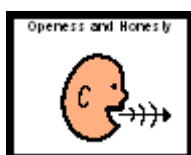

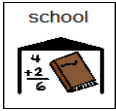
