<u>Picture This</u> Draw a picture and write your spelling words inside of it.	<u>Pyramid Writing</u> Build up a pyramid with each word. E.g. got g go got	<u>ABC Order</u> Neatly write your words in ABC Order from "A-Z" or backwards from "Z-A".	<u>Rainbow Words</u> Write your words 3 times using a range of coloured pencils.	<u>Keyboard Captain</u> Type your words 3 times each. Play with fonts, numbering, colours, and more. Print out if possible.	<u>Word Jumble</u> Ask an adult to jumble up your words and see if you can unscramble them.
<u>Vowel Howl</u> Write all spelling words and highlight all vowels.	<u>Syllable Sets</u> Write out your spelling words and divide them into syllables.	<u>Crossword Craft</u> Create a crossword puzzle with your spelling words. Share with the class to solve.	<u>Ransom Words</u> Cut out letters from magazines, newspapers and/or junk mail and create your words!.	<u>Shout it Out</u> Spell your words aloud for an adult.	<u>Dear.....</u> Use all of your spelling words in a friendly letter.
<u>Kickin' Consonants</u> Write all spelling words and highlight all consonants.	<u>Web of Words</u> Research how to draw a spider web. Draw one and write your words inside of your web. Add a spider to the web.	<u>Workout Words</u> Spell your words aloud as you workout or exercise.	<u>Rap It</u> Write an appropriate, rhyming rap with your spelling words. It can be silly or serious.	<u>Clean Words</u> Write your words in shaving cream. Ask an adult to check your words.	<u>Creative Kid</u> Create your own cool and creative spelling homework task!
