

Welfare Rights Advice

The Welfare Rights Officer based in your school can:

- Complete a full benefits check for you and your household
- Confirm the benefits you are entitled to
- Help you to make a claim for benefits
- Help you to dispute benefit decisions
- Help you to dispute benefit sanctions
- Provide appeal representation
- Complete a referral to partner agency for other needs - eg help with energy costs/debt



Please get in touch if any of the following applies:

- You are on a low income
- You are caring for someone
- You are unable to work due to sickness/disability or recently having a baby
- You have had a change in household circumstances
- You are in a crisis, destitute, or have been made unemployed
- You've had a reduction in earnings
- You've been refused or had a reduction in a benefit
- You need advice or support on any matter relating to state benefits
