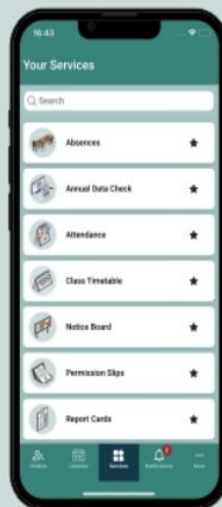

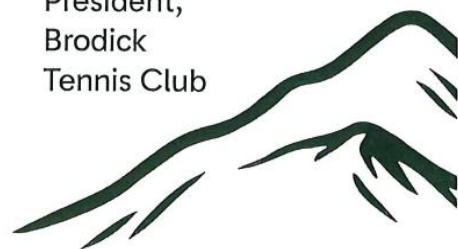
We have adult, junior and household memberships available as well as pay to play sessions for visitors. Bookings can be made online through the LTAs ClubSpark booking platform.

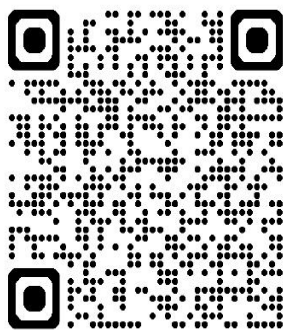

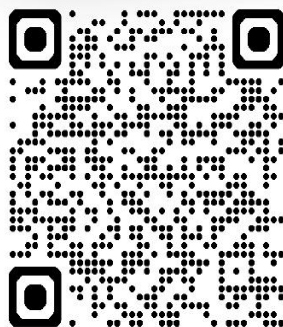
