STAYING SAFE IN WARM WEATHER

Scotland's water bodies can look invitingly cool during periods of warm weather. However, despite the warmth in the air, Scotland's water remains cold, and this can lead to cold water shock and sometimes fatal consequences.

It is important to understand how to keep yourself and other safe when cooling down in Scotland's inland and coastal waters during periods of warm weather.

WARM WEATHER ADVICE

Check for safety signage. This can help inform you of hazards in that area you may not be aware of.



Look out for your friends. If you are at the beach, or loch with your friends make sure to keep an eye out for each other.

Be aware of cold water shock.



Most importantly, learn the Water Safety Code.



Alcohol and water based activities or waterside play don't mix.

WHAT TO DO IN AN EMERGENCY

Should you encounter someone who is in danger in the water during the warm weather, please follow this advice:

- ❗ **Never go into the water to help.** It could put you in danger and could make the situation worse.
- ❗ **Call 999.** Ask for the Coastguard at coastal locations and Police at inland locations.
- ❗ Give **reassurance** and let the person in the water know that help is on the way. Encourage them to stay calm and **float**.
- ❗ Look for **Public Rescue Equipment** whilst you await the arrival of emergency services. If no PRE is available, look for something that could extend your reach such as a long branch or pole to try to help the person back to land. Only do this from solid ground a safe distance from the edge.
- ❗ As much as you can **maintain visual contact** so you can help emergency responders locate the person.
