Let's Listen

Play a game of Simon Says to help you listen carefully to instructions. How good are you? Simon can ask you to do things like — touch your toes, jump high, clap your hands, and so on.

OR

When Simon says 'do this....' you do it and when Simon says 'do that...' you don't do it.

Let's Record

Record yourself reading your favourite book aloud, or retelling a familiar story by looking at the pictures in a book.

How did you sound?

Share it with someone who would enjoy it.

Let's go Searching

Hide 5 toys around your house.

Create a scavenger hunt for someone to find them.

Write clues or you can draw pictures or diagrams to help.

For example you could write.

It is beside....

It is on top of....

It is under.....

It is behind

Let's draw and write

Look for objects around the house or in the garden which begin with every letter of the alphabet.

Once you have found them draw a picture of the object and write what it is.

For example :-

Apple, Book, Carrot, Door.

Add it up!

A1 B3 C3 D2 E1 F4
G2 H4 I1 J8 K5 L1
M3 N1 O1 P3 Q10 R1
S1 T1 U1 V4 W4 X8
Y4 710

Add up your spelling words using the scrabble tiles.

For example :-

cat = 3 + 1 + 1 = 5

Practise spelling cvc words (dog, bat, sun) and your tricky words.

Letter Collage

Use old magazines, catalogues or newspapers to cut out the first letter of your name to create a collage. Can you find lots of different letter styles (fonts)? Perhaps you can find the first letter of everyone who lives in your house.

Email or Text?

Why don't you write an email message or a text message to a friend or a relative.

Ask them some questions on how they are feeling.

Remember you need a question mark at the end of a question sentence. ?

Senses Poem

Use your senses to write a poem about your favourite colour.

For Example:

Red

Red feels like
Red smells like
Red tastes like
Red sounds like
Red looks like
I love red.

Think of all the things associated with that colour, fire, hearts, strawberries, jam, etc.

Other Curricular Area Challenges:

Collage

Collect twigs, branches, leaves and wild flowers from your garden or while out on a walk. Write your name onto a large piece of card or paper and then glue on the things you have collected to make a natural collage of your name.

Create a Song

Practise singing the alphabet to a different tune. Why not try singing ABC to 'Old Mac Donald' or 'Twinkle. Twinkle Little Star.'

Let's Play ball

Go outside and invent a ball game. Think up rules, write them down and add some pictures (maybe with some help from an adult) then play the game.
