

<p><u>I spy a Noun</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A noun is a the name of a place, person or thing. • Look outside your window. Can you name 10 nouns that you can see? For example, tree, car, post box, Postman. 	<p><u>Instructions</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can you write a set of instructions for how to wash your hands or bake a cake? • Remember to include words such as ‘first’ and ‘next’. 	<p><u>Toy hunt</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hide your favourite toy somewhere in the house or garden. • Write some clues to help someone in your family to find it! Eg It is next to something yellow, behind something we use to make toast. 	<p><u>Letter</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write a letter to someone you appreciate and tell them why. • Could it be your Gran or Uncle, or even a neighbour?
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<p><u>Syllable count</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write numbers 1 – 10 on your paper. • Try to find things around the house that have this number of syllables. Remember to clap your hands to check! • Eg 1 – couch, 2 – worktop. 	<p><u>Wordsearch</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use a piece of paper and draw a square with some lines inside it to make boxes. • Write in some tricky words first that you can ask your family to find, then fill in the rest of the boxes with random letters! 	<p><u>Make a Bookmark</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use card or just paper and cut it into a long rectangle. • Choose a book you have enjoyed recently (bug club or otherwise), and make a themed bookmark! • Remember to include pictures and words.
