

Guess the Number

Write a big number on a piece of paper. Hold it behind a blank piece of paper. Slowly reveal the number. How quickly can you child recognise the number? Make it more challenging by holding numbers upside down.

Fill My Cup

You need one dice, two cups and a pile of small objects such as pom poms or lego. Take turns to roll the dice. If you roll a 5, put 5 pom poms in your cup. Winner is the first person to fill their cup.



House Numbers

Go on a walk and write down all the house numbers you see. Do you notice any odd and even patterns?



Time Hunt

Have a look around your home for everything that tells the time i.e. microwave, alarm clocks. Can you find any in magazines? Cut them out and make a clock collage.

Hopscotch

Using chalk draw out a hopscotch game. Shout out the numbers as you jump. Throw a toy, and miss out the number it lands on. Can you challenge yourself by counting and hopping backwards?

Other Curricular Areas:

Art - Symmetrical butterflies
