

Kim's Game

Purpose: To develop visual memory and observational skills

Recommended group size: Maximum of 6



You will need:

- A bag/box/tray
- Assortment of items
- Cloth to cover items

How to carry out activity:

1. Explain to the children you have some objects in your magic bag.
2. Bring out 3-4 objects and place them on the table/tray.
3. Ensure the children can identify each item.
4. Ask the children to look closely at the items and remember them.
5. Explain that you will hide one of the objects and they must spot what item is missing.
6. Remove one of the items using the cloth to cover as you do so.
7. Remind the children they must look carefully and try to visualise what was there before.
8. Ask what item is missing.

Challenge:

- Increase the number of objects as the children get better at the task
- Move positions of the remaining items
- Remove more than one object
