

<p><u>Health and Wellbeing</u></p> <p>This term, we will be looking at 'The Colour Monster' book and talking a lot about different emotions. Children will learn about strategies to help them express and recognise how they are feeling. We will also be looking at our rights as children, and how we can be kind and respectful to each other.</p> <p>During P.E, we will be taking part in lots of games and learning how to be part of a team.</p>	<p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>Primary 2 will be continuing to learn new sounds and tricky words in order to advance with their reading books. The children will have many opportunities to develop their writing skills focusing on letter formation and recognising CVC words.</p> <p>We will be building on existing listening and talking skills as the pupils are encouraged to share their ideas and listen to others.</p>	<p><u>Numeracy</u></p> <p>This term, Primary 2 will be looking at Number Processes and the value of given numbers up to 100. We will also be working on addition and subtraction skills to build the pupils confidence after a long break. The pupils will have plenty of practice to ensure their number formation is accurate.</p>
<p><u>Social Studies</u></p> <p>While learning outdoors in differing weathers, we will describe the weather, its effects and how it makes us feel. We will play our part in caring for the environment by keeping our garden tidy and by re-using or recycling materials in our play. We will independently navigate to, log in and complete activities on learning platforms such as Education City and Bug Club to practice our growing skills across the curriculum. Seesaw will give us opportunities to record and share our learning.</p>
