## Information

A very big hello to all of our lovely families and carers. We have had a busy two weeks since returning from the summer holidays! All the staff and children have been working very hard to build relationships and settle into their new routines. Each month, our school will send out a newsletter to share updates, important information and upcoming events from the school with you to keep you as informed as possible about the wider life of the school. This month we would like to remind everyone of:

<u>Drop off and collection</u> - please remember that the playground remains a very busy place in the morning and the afternoon for drop off and collection. We ask that children do not ride their scooters and bikes in the playground to ensure we can keep everyone safe. In order to not overwhelm our youngest children, soft start for Primary 1 will be available from 8:50am at their classroom doors. In order to keep everyone safe within the school, we ask that adults do not enter the school building through the children's doors in the morning to speak with teachers. Staff will be available each morning within the playground and can pass on any urgent messages.

<u>School Uniform</u> - thank you for your support in promoting our school uniform. This helps to set a standard for our children and build our school community spirit every day.

<u>Attendance</u> - we will continue to monitor children's attendance every 4 weeks to encourage good attendance throughout the year. If you need any support at all please contact the office and we will be happy to help.

<u>Meet the Teacher</u> - this will be an exciting opportunity for you to come in and see your child's learning environment. In order to not over crowd classrooms, we ask that only one adult per child attend this event.

<u>Seesaw</u> - please remember to check your child's Seesaw account for updates on their targets and work throughout the session. Please speak with a member of staff if you are having trouble accessing this.

Check it Tuesday' - is a great way to ensure you are checking for unwanted visitors each week. Should you find any head lice, please speak to a local pharmacist and also let the office staff know.
