

<p><u>Health and Wellbeing</u></p> <p>Our main focus this term is establishing class routines to make the school day run smoothly. This will help develop our class community. We are proud to be a Rights Respecting School. Our learners will explore their rights through the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child. This will help them make positive choices when moving, learning and playing with others. Children will discuss emotions as they learn about zones of regulation. In P.E. we will play team games.</p>	<p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>Primary One children will explore rhythm and rhyme through stories and songs. They will develop their knowledge of letters and the sounds they make. Primary Two learners will continue to make progress on our phonics programme, increasing their knowledge of spelling sounds and tricky words. Reading sessions will develop skills in blending and using expression when reading aloud. All pupils will develop listening skills, taking turns and looking at the speaker.</p>	<p><u>Numeracy</u></p> <p>Primary One will recognise, describe and create patterns with shapes, numbers and pictures. Small group teaching, games and activities in class will help pupils learn to identify numbers and count objects. Learners will also explore numbers before and after and organise groups of numbers. Primary Two will continue to develop and build on their own knowledge of shapes and focus on Place Value and ordering 2 digit numbers.</p>
<p><u>Social Studies</u></p> <p>All pupils will have daily opportunities to share the Play Zone with their peers from other classes. Pupils will independently log in to, and complete activities on a variety of educational sites. Seesaw will give opportunities to record and share learning, with each other and families.</p>
