We will have meaningful conversations about feelings through Zones of Regulation. For PE, we will be playing community building games and learning how to keep each other safe. In November, we will have a Road Safety week. Also, we will be learning some social dances for Christmas.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>P3 will be looking at Traditional Tales and will be given the opportunity to ask and answer questions about the books we are reading. We will use these tales to write detailed descriptions of character and setting. Also, we will use our SHORS skills including visualisation to evidence our thoughts and feelings. Primary 3 will be continuing to learn new sounds and tricky words in order to advance with their reading books and sentence writing.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Numeracy</u></p> <p>This term, Primary 3 will be looking at Number Processes and the value of numbers to 120 and beyond. We will use symbols to describe relationships between numbers. Daily, we will answer questions mentally, discussing strategies. We will be using partitioning and friendly numbers to add and subtract.</p>
