

Numeracy P1 - We will use money to pay for items up to 10p and we will become familiar with other coins and notes. We will also investigate position and direction, linking this with programmable or remote-controlled toys. We will learn how to read a calendar to find specific dates, most importantly our own birthdays! We will continue to use numbers up to 20 and become confident in adding and subtracting. P2 - Pupils will continue to work with 2 digit numbers, rounding to the nearest ten. We will be looking at Money, identifying coins, understanding the value of coins, making amounts and giving change. Both – continued focus on the 4 operations of addition, subtractions, division and multiplication.

We will also use evidence from the past to develop our learning further.
