

<p><u>Health and Wellbeing</u></p> <p>This term during PE, we will be working on Gymnastics using large apparatus, creative dance and hockey.</p> <p>For Outdoor Learning this term we will focus on exploring using loose parts. Primary 5 will link this to Science: exploring body systems and cells. Primary 6 will use loose parts through Drama, creating scripts and performing.</p>	<p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>Primary 6/5 will be continuing to focus on VCOP and applying this to our writing with increasing independence. We will look at continuing a story in the same style as the author. For reading, we will work on reading with fluency and expression.</p> <p>We will continue to work on improving our reading comprehension skills to have a better understanding of various texts. We will be looking at Scots poetry and will be learning 'To a Mouse' by Robert Burns.</p>	<p><u>Numeracy</u></p> <p>This term for Numeracy, we will be looking at fractions and decimals. We will continue to learn mental maths strategies and look at how we can apply these to our work to help support ourselves when we are stuck.</p> <p>For Beyond Number we will be looking at the topic of Time.</p>

In the Discovery Zone we will be completing a range of activities where pupils will gain a breadth of understanding.</p>	<p><u>Technology</u></p> <p>For Term 2, Primary 6/5 will be looking at different features, for example Word, PowerPoint and Excel. They will gain skills in typing, navigating and applying lifelong digital knowledge. We will be working closely with our P5/4 digital leaders to learn more about this.</p>
