

<p><u>Health and Wellbeing</u></p> <p>Over Term 3, the pupils will look at ‘Our Bodies’ and the changes brought on by puberty; both physically and mentally.</p> <p>P.E. will involve developing fitness as we focus on becoming quicker and stronger in athletics. We will look at the importance of form when completing different activities.</p>	<p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>Primary 5/4 will continue to develop their abilities in reading, writing, and listening and talking over Term 3. We will refine all the skills we have learnt over the year and be able to confidently apply them when required.</p> <p>Please encourage your child to read books at home on Active Learn and answer the ‘bugs’ as this greatly improves comprehension.</p>	<p><u>Numeracy</u></p> <p>Term 3 will recap a lot of the learning we have completed so far in Primary 5/4 through our focus of algebra and number patterns. Pupils apply the four operations (adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing) through a variety of strategies.</p> <p>For Beyond Number, we will be looking at Time. This can be a tricky concept for some pupils and will require additional support at home to apply learning to daily events.</p>
<p><u>Social Studies</u></p> <p>This term P5/4 will be looking sustainability. This will be very pupil led topic, which will allow pupils to apply their research skills as well as to present their learning in an engaging way. Throughout these topic areas, we will also be exploring different careers available in STEM.</p>	<p><u>Technology</u></p> <p>Primary 5/4 will continue to develop their technology skills by educating younger pupils. The P5/4s will be mainly working with P3s to develop their digital literacy, as well as how to be safe online.</p>
