

<p><b><u>Health and Wellbeing</u></b></p> <p>Health and Wellbeing, we will be starting the Emotion Works programme, focusing on the orange and green cogs. This will help us build our emotional vocabulary and understand our behaviours—learning to recognise how we feel, how our emotions can change throughout the day, the different types of friendships, what bullying means, and how we can show our school values. In gym, we will be developing our skills in netball, gymnastics, rugby and social dancing.</p>	<p><b><u>Literacy</u></b></p> <p>Our reading focus will be on developing strategies such as summarising a story in our own words and visualising by identifying key descriptive language. We'll develop our comprehension skills by responding to literal, inferential and evaluative questions In Grammar, we will be focusing on singular and plural nouns, learning how to use apostrophes for possession, choosing the correct homophones, and creating our own similes and metaphors.</p>	<p><b><u>Numeracy</u></b></p> <p>In Maths, we will be learning about shape by exploring how 3D nets are made from 2D shapes. We will also be investigating angles—understanding degrees in relation to compass points, as well as practising how to estimate and measure angles.</p> <p>In numeracy, we will be developing our skills across the four operations; exploring different strategies and larger numbers.</p>
<p><b><u>Social Studies</u></b></p> <p>Through our class novel, we will learn about different people and how they live in other parts of the world. We will see how friends can help each other, even if they are very different.
