This term, our Primary 1 children will continue to build on their skills in reading, writing, and listening and talking. They will be encouraged to use their knowledge of letters and sounds to write simple sentences, remembering to include capital letters and full stops. In reading, the children will apply their understanding of sounds and their recall of tricky words to read with increasing fluency and confidence. Through a range of engaging activities, they will develop their communication skills and become more independent learners.

Numeracy

This term in Numeracy, our Primary 1 children will continue to build on their understanding of number by extending their addition and subtraction skills, including solving missing number calculations. They will explore symmetry by identifying, describing, and creating symmetrical pictures. In Information Handling, the children will use their knowledge of colour, shape, and size to sort items in different ways, as well as develop their ability to interpret simple graphs, charts, and signs. These experiences will help strengthen their problem-solving skills and confidence in using maths in everyday contexts.

Health and Wellbeing
