This month in our school...

April has brought a real sense of energy across the school, with children engaging positively in their learning and showing increasing confidence as they apply new skills and knowledge. It has been encouraging to see the progress being made across all stages.

Headlice Reminder - We kindly remind all parents and carers to check their children's hair weekly for headlice. Regular checks help prevent the spread and allow for early treatment if needed. Free treatment and advice are available from local pharmacies. Thank you for helping us keep our school community healthy and comfortable.

World Of Work Week - Our World of Work Week, organised by Mrs Scott, provided children with valuable insights into a range of careers. It was great to see their enthusiasm and engagement throughout the week, and how confidently they engaged with visitors and new learning experiences.

P7 Transition - Our P7 pupils are continuing their transition to secondary, with a range of visits and events coming up to support this important next step, and they are now welcome to wear their leavers' hoodies to school each day if they wish.

Warmer Weather - As the weather becomes warmer, we kindly ask that children come to school with sunscreen already applied on sunny days to help keep them safe while outdoors.

School Trips - We are pleased to share that each class will have the opportunity to take part in a school trip this term. Following our family survey last session, 98% of families indicated they would be comfortable contributing £5; however, as a school, and with the support of the Parent Council, we are subsidising costs as much as possible, meaning families will only be asked to contribute £2. Further details will be shared in due course.

Nut Free School - As a reminder, we are a nut-free school due to a number of children with severe allergies, and we ask that no nut products are included in packed lunches or snacks. Your support with this is essential in helping us keep all children safe.

Car Park Reminder - We continue to experience some concerns in the car park and would remind all families to use this area safely and responsibly at all times. Your cooperation is important in helping us ensure the safety of all children, families and staff.
