This term we will be learning about the following:

Literacy & English: Reading, Writing, Talking & Listening

This term we will be focussing on how to improve our writing using vocabulary, connecting words, interesting sentence openers and punctuation. We will also be exploring how to use a dictionary. In French, we will be learning numbers up to 31 and use them to tell others when our birthday is. We will be reciting poetry for our Scottish Assembly and also performing for our own class assembly.

Numeracy & Mathematics:

In Numeracy, we will be learning to recognise number patterns such as odd and even and using these patterns to count in 5's and 10's. We will be learning to add and subtract using partitioning. In Maths, we will be sorting information using diagrams and investigating positional language.



Our topic is: Vikings

We will be creating models of Viking longboats and helmets. We will investigate how Vikings lived, what clothes and food they had and where they invaded. We will take a particular look at how Viking life affected Scotland. We will explore the role of an archaeologist and prepare presentations about the Vikings.

Our Health and Well-being will focus on: how to react in unsafe situations and how to access emergency help.

In PE we will: be exploring balances, jumps and rolls through gymnastics and learn how to sequence these movements together to create a routine.

In Technologies (including ICT) we will: be creating 3D models with moving parts and Viking textiles. We will also be looking at how we can be safe online and be responsible digital citizens.

In RE we will: be looking at the story of Holy Week that follows Jesus's journey to the cross and how it relates to Easter celebrations.

Expressive Arts (Art, Music, Drama, Dance)

Art: We will be creating images using mixed media and incorporating texture using tone and pattern.

Music and Drama: We will be learning songs and performing for our class assembly.
