This term we will be learning about the following:

## Literacy & English: Reading, Writing, Talking & Listening

This term we will be exploring our class novel using prediction skills to suggest what might be happening next in our story and exploring the language used. We will be writing creative pieces about life in a chocolate factory and imagining our own recipes for chocolate creations and bubble gum meals! We will deliver a short talk about who we would like to win a dream trip to the chocolate factory and debate the pros and cons of TV.

## Numeracy & Mathematics:

In Numeracy, we will be focussing on learning our times tables facts. We will be comparing numbers up to 100 and we will be discussing the tools we can use to help. We will also be exploring fractions.



**Our topic is:** Charlie and the Chocolate factory We will investigate the journey of chocolate from bean to bar and learn what the term 'Fairtrade' means and where we can access Fairtrade product1. We will look at the science behind forces and how Augustus was forced through the glass pipe. We will also create our own adverts using the ipads to film.

Our Health and Well-being will focus on: how plastic can damage our environment and use what we have learned to implement recycling awareness around the school. In PE we will: be focussing on good teamwork. We will be learning skills in gymnastics and

basketball.

In Technologies (including ICT) we will: be following and making recipes related to our novel study. We will be learning how to use kitchen equipment safely and the importance of hygiene when cooking. We will also use our problem solving skills to build candy towers.

In RE we will: be exploring famous religious buildings, both here and around the world, and discover their importance to various religions.
