This term we will be learning about the following:

Literacy & English:

Reading: We will be continuing to develop our reading skills through reading homework and reading in class including during ERIC time, library and comprehension tasks. We will also be developing our literal and inferential comprehension skills.

Writing: We will continue to develop our knowledge of VCOP and use this to up-level our writing. We will also consolidate and begin to develop our knowledge of grammar.

Listening and Talking: We will consolidate our basic listening skills and beginning to develop our oral skills during discussions and debates.

Numeracy

We will continue to consolidate our number bonds and table facts daily. We will also be exploring place value, partitioning and multiples of 10 and 100.

Mathematics

We will be exploring different units of measurement, and how and why measurement is used in everyday life.

Our topic is:

Weather and Climate. We will be exploring the different varieties of weather systems and the effects these can have on our every changing climate.

Social and Emotional Health including friendships, caring, sharing, fairness and equality.
