Health and Wellbeing



Our P.E. days are Monday and Thursday.

We will focus on taking part in a variety of activities with different roles.

As part of Health and Wellbeing we will be focussing on being active, discussing different food choices and exploring Quality Education as part of our Sustainable Development Goal focus.

Expressive Arts

Music - We will listen to and discuss the features of traditional Scottish and Japanese music.



Art - We will explore the work of a variety of Scottish Artists such as Charles Rennie Mackintosh to incorporate line, tone and texture. We will explore a variety of Japanese themed art.



Drama - This term we will be expressing our ideas on cultural diversity through verbal and non-verbal role play.



Numeracy :

This term the Squares group will focus on building up our times table skills for the 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 10 times tables. We will use our times table facts to help us divide. We will also be estimating and rounding numbers within 1000.

The Triangle group will explore time focussing on hours and minutes. We will be using the terms o'clock and half past. We will also match analogue and digital times for o'clock and half past. We will then explore collecting, organising and displaying information using tables, bar graphs, Venn and Carroll diagrams.

RME : We will explore the Christian story of Easter and the differences between Christian celebrations and other World religions.

Science : We will be discussing and developing imaginative ideas to create a product of the future. We will also consider the different ways technologies help the world.

Literacy

Reading - This term we will continue to explore SHORS reading comprehension strategies. We will also further develop our reading comprehension skills through our Bug Club books.

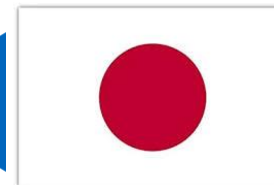
Writing - This term we will continuing to use our PM writing resource focussing on writing an information report and a narrative text.

Talking and Listening - We will be reciting a Scots poem and working on our pronunciation of Scottish words. We will also work on our active listening skills through different group activities.



Topic

Our topic this term will be a comparative study between Scotland and Japan. We will explore the similarities and differences between culture, landscape and environment. We will also investigate the main features of weather, climate and discuss the impact of this on living things.
