### Health and Wellbeing



This term work will focus on developing a range of gross motor skills using apparatus. The apparatus will be set up in work stations in the gym. Work carried out last term has given the children confidence in using different apparatus to allow these activities to take place. Group games will be introduced and turn taking and following rules worked on.

We will continue to work on staying calm during transitions and working with others.

### Mathematics

In Numeracy work will continue to focus on extending each child's knowledge of numbers in accordance with their individual targets. This will include recognition, understanding and formation of numbers and ordinal numbers, ordering and sequencing and work on time and money, addition and subtraction. Outdoor learning will continue to be used to enhance practical experience of numeracy where appropriate.



### Literacy



In Literacy the focus will be on extending each child's individual literacy levels. Work will continue on letter formation and writing their names and underwriting simple sentences using a variety of materials e.g. whiteboards, smartboard, pens, pencils, chalk and paint. Each child will continue to be issued with a reading book and stories will be read daily. The school library will be visited weekly to enhance the development of reading skills. The class library will be used several times each week.

Different communication tools will be used within the class e.g. use of visuals, Makaton and spoken language.

### Inter-Disciplinary Learning

Outside learning will continue to be a big part of our week. We hope to explore more of our local community and make use of the outdoor classroom. Good use will be made of our waterproofs!



Different types of sensory play both indoors and outside will continue to be experienced.

In ICT different interactive games on the smartboard will be explored with a focus on turn taking.

Science will continue to focus on 'Winter and Ice Experiments'.

Our topic for the term will be 'Scotland'



### Expressive Arts

Music continues to be a firm favourite in CB10. This term we will work on learning some new songs which will allow us to explore high and low pitch, play rhythm games and create our own sounds using our voices and instruments. Different mediums will be used during our topic work to produce art in various forms. This will also include seasonal art for Winter and Spring.
