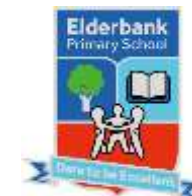


# Elderbank Primary School

## Home / School Information



### Health and Wellbeing

This term we will be learning about our emotions and how to deal with them during different situations. We will also learn about our own personal hygiene.

In P.E we will begin with learning more gymnastic skills. We will also perform a variety of moves and skills to music during dance. We will also play badminton and learn how to score points in a game.



### Numeracy

**Squares** - We will continue to explore working on the four functions and using our skills to work on number and word problems. We will also work on completing number equations.

**Triangles** - We will investigate the four processes: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, to help us solve a variety of number/word problems. We will also continue to develop our skills in multiplying/dividing by 4 and 5.



### Maths

We will be working on measuring the length of objects in centimetres, metres and kilometres. We will learn to convert between centimetres and using different devices to measure a variety of objects. We will also look at measuring the weight of objects in kilograms and grams and converting between the two.

### Science

In Term 3, P5 will be investigating and explaining the actions of some microorganisms and their role in food production, (e.g. bread). We will explore microorganisms, including bacteria, viruses and fungi and how they can multiply rapidly.

### RME

We will be learning about holy week for Easter. We will learn about retelling the Easter story and explain how Christians celebrate Easter and the traditions that they follow.



### IDL

We will be learning all about Scotland, our traditions and about the history of our country. We will also investigate the Rebellion of the Jacobites in Britain.



### Expressive Arts

**Music**- We will work on beats and rhythms and music and will use our skills/knowledge to play along to music using tuned/untuned percussion instruments. We will also listen to and play/sing along to Scottish Folk music and identify instruments within it.

**Art** - We will continue to investigate texture and use of shape and line. We will look at Scottish artists and try some of their techniques on our own art work.

### Outdoor Learning

### Literacy

**Reading** - We will continue to read a variety of stories, novels and genres to develop our awareness of different techniques within a variety of texts. We will be working on summarising, concluding and inferring skills in comprehension.



**Writing** - We will be learning about the features of an information report and narrative and will use these to write/create our own. We will be learning about plural nouns and how to use past and present tense regular/irregular verbs.

**Talking and Listening** - We will be working on our Attention and Listening skills, focusing on being able to listen to and think about words in order to follow instructions. We will also be working on taking turns during group or class discussions. We will be reciting Scots poems.
