

John Muir Family Award for P4 - P7 families

The John Muir Family Award is an environmental award scheme encouraging young people and families to enjoy and care for local wild spaces .

Pupils and their family will be supported to achieve the John Muir DISCOVERY Family Award. The Award is approximately 25 hours time commitment which is split between time in school and time at home and families will complete these 4 challenges.:

Discover, Explore, Conserve and Share

- There will be one session per week for **6 weeks** (approx. 60-90 mins) with young people during the school day or with families afterschool.
- To help support the time commitment required for this award, parents are asked to work with their child on outdoor home activities. These activities will be emailed by the FLW to parents weekly.
- Parents will also receive planned support phone calls throughout the programme from their Family Learning Worker. This is to find out how they are all managing the home tasks.
- Pupils will complete their John Muir scrapbooks and families will provide photos of their own outdoor adventures to their Family Learning worker by email.
- Your Family Learning Worker will support pupils to achieve their challenges through planning, logging and reviewing their work.
- Evidence of activities will be recorded by the Family Learning Worker and the John Muir Trust will provide award certificates accordingly.
