We will be using a range of media to create a variety of objects and images. We will also be doing a variety of art activities based around our topic 'Pugs of the Frozen North'.


Drama -

Maths:



The Circle group will explore the 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10 times table. We will use our multiplication facts to help us divide. Both the Square and Circle group will also explore estimating and measuring volume using millilitres and litres. The Triangle group will focus on adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers using carrying and exchange. We will also explore lines of symmetry and symmetrical shapes.

<u>RME</u>: This term we will focus on the special buildings linked to different religions. We will learn about the key features of a Synagogue and what happens in a Mosque.

<u>Science</u>: We will be learning about parts of a plant, different plant types and environments where plants grow.

Literacy

<u>Reading</u> - This term we will further develop our reading comprehension skills through our topic novel 'Pugs of the Frozen North', our group novels and PM books. We will also explore SHORS reading comprehension strategies.

<u>Writing</u> - This term we will be continuing to use our PM writing resource. We will focus on recount and imaginative writing.

<u>Talking and Listening</u> - We will develop our listening and talking skills through a variety of attention and listening games and activities. We will focus on being able to take turns to speak, listening to others and asking our peers questions.

We will be reading the novel 'Pugs of the Frozen North' by Philip Reeve and Sarah McIntyre. We will be using our research skills to find out all about climate change and the Arctic.
