Based around our topic, we will explore a range of media to create a variety of images. We will also be exploring art techniques using our class novel.




We will be developing our role play skills. We will be focussing on taking on a role using facial expressions and tone of voice.

Numeracy:



Squares: This term we will be focussing on multiplication and division. We will be practising the 6, 7 and 8 times tables and exploring how to use this knowledge to multiply and divide single and double digit numbers.

Circles & Triangles: We will be revisiting multiplications and recall of times tables, as well as the link between multiplication and division. We will use our division skills to understand and find fractions.

RME:

This term we will focus on the special buildings linked to different religions. We will focus on the Synagogue and the Mosque, discussing their key features and what happens in each of them.

Literacy:

Reading - This term we will further develop our reading strategies and comprehension skills through our group novels, as well as our class novel 'Pugs of the Frozen North'.

Writing - This term, we will be learning about the features of recounts before planning and writing our own recounts.

Talking and Listening - We will be developing our talking and listening skills using a variety of attention and listening activities as a class and within smaller groups. We will focus on being able to listen while others are speaking and asking appropriate questions.





Topic:

Our topic this term will be the Polar Regions. We will be investigating differences between the Arctic and the Antarctic. We will be exploring the people and animals that live there, as well as the climate.

This topic is also linked to our class novel 'Pugs of the Frozen North'.



Science:

This term, we will be learning about plants. We will be investigating the best conditions plants need to grow, as well as completing practical activities to track and record plant growth.



Homework:

Homework task grids will be available in both paper copy format, as well as on Seesaw. All activities will be discussed in class.
