Numeracy

Circles will be extending their knowledge of place value when working with decimal fractions. They will also be simplifying and solving algebraic equations. Squares will be applying their knowledge of time to practical tasks, involving calculating durations. Also, they will be ordering, comparing and converting fractions. Triangles will be estimating and weighing during practical tasks. As well as this, they will be learning how to calculate the area and perimeter of shapes.

Literacy

<u>Reading</u> - This term we will continue to develop our comprehension skills through a variety of texts including our class novel 'The Explorer', working in groups and independently to further our understanding of issues covered.

<u>Writing</u> - Our focus this term is to up level our writing. We will focus on the features of writing a recount.

<u>Talking and Listening</u> - The children will be engaging with attention and listening lessons. They will be developing their skills in active listening.





Topic - Our topic this term is Endangered Animals. We will discuss the impact of human activity, climate and weather on habitats around the world.

Science - We will be investigating the classification of living and non-living things.

RME - We will focus on the Jewish festival of Purim and the story of Esther discussing the key themes.

ICT - We will develop our presentation skills using PowerPoint including inserting audio/video clips.

<u>Homework</u>

Homework task boards will be given out each month, covering 4 weeks' worth of homework. This may include a mixture of literacy, numeracy, outdoor learning and health and wellbeing. We ask that 2-4 tasks are completed per week. Any written work can be put into homework jotters and brought into school to be marked.
